Heard Shri A. Deshpande, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Shri P.S. Tembhare, learned A.G.P. for respondents. With their consent and considering the nature of controversy, Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal by issuing Rule, making the same returnable forthwith.

2. The impugned order passed by the respondent Scrutiny Committee dated 26.06.2018, is common, i.e. in case of Sisters and Cousin Sisters. Applicant no.4 therein - Ku. Anushree, is given validity by this Court on 26.07.2018 while deciding Writ Petition No.7560/2018.

3. There are validities issued earlier and the same were also pressed into service before the Scrutiny Committee.

4. In this situation, we quash and set aside the impugned order passed by respondent Scrutiny Committee so far as it relates to present petitioner and direct the said Committee to immediately issue validity in her favour i.e. Ku. Tejaswini Suresh Dadmal.

5. Writ Petition is accordingly allowed. Rule is made absolute in aforesaid terms, with no order as to costs.
