- 2. It is not in dispute that the controversy is covered by judgment dated 30.08.2018 in Writ Petition No. 5171 of 2018 and other connected matters. In that writ petition, identical orders passed by the very same Scrutiny Committee have been set aside by this Court. Here, the petitioner has got three validities in the family and apart from that, all documents consistently record caste as "Mana".
- 3. Hence, for the reasons given in the judgment dated 30.08.2018, we quash and set aside the impugned order dated 18.07.2018 and direct the Scrutiny Committee to issue validity to the petitioner as "*Mana Scheduled Tribe*" candidate. Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. No order as to costs.
