- 2. After hearing respective counsel, it is not in dispute that controversy is covered by judgment delivered in Writ Petition No.5171/2018 and other connected matters on 30th August, 2018.
- 3. All old documents recording caste as Mana consistently are not found to be interpolated. Only reason for invalidating caste claim is general observation about "Mani", "Mane", "Mani Kunbi", etc. which has been dealt with by us already.
- 4. We therefore quash and set aside order dated 14th June, 2018 and direct Scrutiny Committee to grant petitioner validity as "Mana"
