1. Heard learned counsel for the parties. Rule. Heard forthwith by consent of parties.

The ground relied upon by the petitioner for issuance of direction to respondent Committee is that real cousin uncle from the paternal side by name Vilas Laxman Jiotode has been granted validity as he belonging to "Mana" scheduled tribe by respondent no. 1 Committee on 5.8.2010. There is no dispute about the grant of validity to the blood relation on paternal side of the petitioner and, therefore, going by the settled principles of law, we see no reason as to why the petition should not be allowed.
- 3. Writ Petition is allowed. The impugned order is hereby quashed and set aside. It is directed that respondent Committee shall issue the validity certificate to the petitioners as they belonging to "Mana" Scheduled tribe within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order.
- 4. Rule is made absolute in the above terms. No costs.
