1. Rule. Rule is made returnable forthwith. Heard finally
by consent of the learned counsel for the parties.
2. There is a pre-Constitutional document, which shows
that birth of a child *Tanya Laxman Mana* has been registered with

Health Department of Panchayat Samiti, Chimur on 30.07.1940.

It is stated that the child *Tanya*, is a grandfather of the petitioner and his name appears in the family tree.

3. There is no dispute about the relationship as well as the genuineness of the document. Therefore, we are of the view that the facts of this case are squarely covered by the view taken by us in Writ Petition No. 2834/2018 decided on 31.01.2019.

4. In this view of the matter, the writ petition is allowed. The impugned order is hereby quashed and set aside. Respondent no.1-Committee is directed to issue validity certificate in the name of the petitioner, within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order.

Rule is made absolute in the above terms. No order as to costs.
