3. In case of the caste claim involved in this petition, the support is from pre-constitutional document of the year 1920-1923 in the nature Extract of Revenue Document P-1. It is issued in the name of grand-father of the petitioner namely Ramchandra. The relationship is not in dispute nor is in dispute the genuineness of the document. Therefore, this petition in our view is squarely covered by the view taken by this Court in Writ Petition No.2834/2018, decided on 31st January, 2019.

- 4. Writ Petition is allowed. Impugned order is hereby quashed and set aside. Respondent No.1-Committee is directed to issue validity certificate in the name of petitioner within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order.
- 5. Rule is made absolute in the above terms. No costs.
