

- 4. The impugned order dated 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 passed by respondent Scrutiiny Committee is quashed and set aside.
- 5. The Scrutiny Committee is directed to issue Caste Validity Certificate to the petitioner as she belonging to "Mana-Schedule Tribe", within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of this order.
- 6. Rule is made absolute in these terms. No costs.
