The genealogy is not disputed by the learned AGP. He also does not dispute, that Ganesh has a son by name Himanshu, to whom the validity has been granted by the Caste Scrutiny Committee in pursuance to the judgment of this Court in Writ Petition No.5102 of 2023 (Himanshu s/o Ganesh Pawar v. The State of Maharashtra and others), decided on 02/02/2024. He also does not dispute, that Yash, son of Sachin (the present petitioner) has also been granted validity by the Committee on 30/08/2024, copy of which is taken on record and marked as 'X' for the purpose of identification. Since these two validities are not disputed, and so also the relationship with the petitioner of these persons is not disputed, we have no hesitation in quashing and setting aside the impugned decision dated 30/12/2022 (Pg.96), passed by the Caste Scrutiny Committee and directing the Committee to grant validity to the petitioner



too. The petition is accordingly allowed in the above terms. The Caste Scrutiny Committee, Amravati is directed to grant validity to the petitioner of belonging to the Scheduled Tribe Thakur. The same shall be done within a period of two weeks from today. The petition stands allowed accordingly. No costs.
